



STRINGS ATTACHED REGISTRATION

for the LSO 2016-2017 Season

The LSO's **Strings Attached** program provides 2nd through 5th grade students with a **free in-school, hands-on violin experience**. For this program, an LSO musician visits up to 30 children per class in a general education classroom or during their music period for a 30-40 minute violin lesson. Each child is provided with a 1/2 size or 3/4 size violin to play for the class period.

Scheduling: Back to back morning and early afternoon classes can be scheduled for Strings Attached. In order to accommodate instrument transportation, **instruments will be brought to the school the morning of the school's first SA class or the afternoon before the school's first SA class and should remain in a locked classroom between SA classes**. If a teacher is scheduling for more than one school, all classes for school "A" will be completed before instruments are transported to school "B."

Venue: The Strings Attached program works in an open space or with tables. It is best for all classes at a given school to meet in the same classroom to accommodate for instrument transportation.
